Paulo Farmhouse Alberto is former Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities of the University of Lisbon (2013-2018).

Previously he was Vice-Dean (2008-2013), President of the Department of Classical Studies (2007-2008), and Vice-President of the Scientific Board (2004-2005). Full Professor, his Ph.D. is on Classical Studies (Classical and Late-Antique Latin Literature).

He has been working on philological criticism of the sixth- and seventh-century authors of Visigothic Spain, namely on textual history and critical editions. He has published a dozen books in Portugal, Italy, Belgium and Germany, and several dozens of articles in academic journals and collective volumes. He has presented conferences and papers at international congresses and meetings in Spain, U.K., France, Italy and Portugal, and delivered seminars in Ph.D. and master degree programs in Italy and Spain.

He has been the head of research projects at the Centre for Classical Studies funded by the Portuguese National Research Agency (FCT), and participated in research projects in Portugal and Spain, funded by the national agencies.
